How does it work?





Live Lessons

- You will follow a timetable which will include participating in live lessons scheduled throughout the week for each subject.
- These lessons will also be attended by students who are attending face-to-face lessons. You will be able to talk with your teacher and other students in the face-to-face classes.
- Your subject teacher will send you a [link on your calendar](#) to join live lessons on [Teams Video](#).



Flipped Learning

We will use **Flipped Learning** in how we teach and how you learn this term.

What is **Flipped Learning** and how is it different to Live Lessons?

- **Flipped Learning** is when you are encouraged to think for yourself about the topic studied.
- This is a teaching method that encourages you to think and work more **independently** outside of your live lessons in allocated periods or in your own time.
- You will work through **interactive self-study materials** in your own time to develop an understanding of subject content, supported by live lessons with your subject teachers.
- **Self-Study Materials** have been designed with interactive webinars and extension material for you to use during timetabled lessons when not in a live lesson.



Mentors

- You will have **daily Mentor sessions** that offer you individualised support for your learning goals and reflect on your weekly progress through Individual Performance Plans.
- Mentors will support your engagement and wellbeing each day.
- You will also have a meeting with your individual **Success Coach (Mr Smith or Ms Clarke)** who will be available daily for further support.



Technical requirements

To access and complete the online learning lessons successfully you will need:

- Access to **internet**
- **Computer** / laptop
- **Printer** and/or device with a scanning app



Microsoft Teams

We will be using **Microsoft Teams** as our online platform.

- All your **assignments** will be uploaded onto Microsoft Teams and structured for you to access, complete and upload.
- All **communication** and **feedback** from assignments will be on Microsoft Teams.
- **Live lessons** will be timetabled to access via Microsoft Teams.
- There may also be **videos, quizzes, assignments**, and tasks specific to each subject.
- You will be provided with dedicated **electronic pages from all textbooks** needed for each subject.



Course Materials

- There will be a **multi-media approaches** to learning including live online classes, videos, subscription quizzes, assignments, practical work as some examples of many approaches offered.
- Some subjects such as **Art or Science** may require you to have **additional specialist materials** to complete assignments. Your subject teachers will be able to provide support in acquiring any materials you need.



Assessment

- All subjects will have **Assignments** throughout the 7 weeks.
- These will be marked by subject teachers who will respond with **individual feedback** for you on Teams.
- Your assignments and any test results will be added to your **Individual Performance Plan**.



Individual Performance Plans

- You will have your **own plan** that is monitored by your mentor and informed by weekly subject reports and pastoral activities.
- It will identify growth and development of your **key skills** and **competencies**.
- It will give immediate feedback on your **progress** on a weekly basis.



University and Careers

We provide support for students to choose a UK or international university, choose a Football Pathway, prepare for their university application and interviews, write their personal statement, and apply through UCAS.

For Year 13 students applying to university, you will have already started their research on choosing a university throughout the last term with the support of your mentor.
